IN THE CIRCUIT COURT, FOURTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT, IN AND FOR DUVAL COUNTY

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING RESIDENTIAL FORECLOSURE DIVISION

Because of the lack of available Senior Judges, the Court has determined that responsibility for presiding over Residential Foreclosure Civil Actions shall be returned to the presiding civil judges for each respective civil division.

Each civil division has published procedures for the scheduling and conduct of hearings, trials or other proceedings for Residential Foreclosure Cases. These procedures are published on the Official Website of the Fourth Judicial Circuit.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED:

- 1. All hearings or court proceedings in Residential Foreclosure Cases set on the Friday unified calendar on October 25th, 2024, or a later Friday, are canceled.
- 2. The Residential Foreclosure Procedures for each Civil Division are incorporated in the terms of this Order.

3. All attorneys or unrepresented parties shall consult and follow the foreclosure procedures published for each division. These procedures include the rescheduling of hearings and other court proceedings as well as how to communicate with the Court regarding the scheduling of trials, hearings or other proceedings and the submission to the Court of correspondence, motions, proposed orders and other communications regarding residential foreclosure cases.
